<b>Advanced Placement (AP)</b>	Courses designed to prepare a student to earn college credit through the successful completion of the AP exam. In person & online opportunities.	9-12	5

# *Advanced Placement*



- Allows students to take college level coursework
- AP scores may translate to college credit (scores of 3+)
- Exam fee = \$99\*
- AP Seminar/Research Exam fee = \$147\*
- Exams take place in May
- Know how your AP courses could transfer to college

# *AP Capstone Awards*

- **AP Capstone Certificate**

- Must earn scores of 3+ in both AP Seminar and AP Research.

- **AP Capstone Diploma**

- Must earn scores of 3+ on AP Seminar, AP Research AND 4 other AP exams



# ***Vol State Dual Enrollment - Eligibility***

- **3.6 GPA or qualifying ACT scores**
  - Eng. & Humanities courses: Reading 19, English 18
  - Math courses: Math 19
- **Dual Enrollment Grant Application**
  - This covers the cost of your course(s)
  - Must maintain a minimum 2.0 college GPA to receive grant
- **Current Sophomores - take ACT before next year if you don't have a 3.6 GPA**

# *TCAT Hartsville Dual Enrollment*

- DE Metalworking & DE Mechatronics
- Can take once a semester each year
  - Once prerequisites are met
- Build up your hours towards TCAT certification

# Dual Enrollment Grant

- Must be a junior or senior for any course taken w/ a 2 or 4 yr college
  - Grant covers courses 1-5; for courses 6-10 it's covered at a rate of \$100 per credit hour
- Must be a 9th-12th grader for any TCAT course
  - Grant covers up to 1296 clock hours
- Must maintain a college GPA of 2.0
- Must complete DE grant application by the beginning of the course

- Credit
- Can take up to once per semester
- Must have a job
